DIRECTIONS:

Manholes and Mains: In manhole, **United 987 COLD-BAC BLOCK** should be placed in the invert nearly vertically on the upstream end of the U channel.

Lift Stations: **United 987 COLD-BAC BLOCK** should be used in low flow applications. Suspend the block so the entire block is submerged below the water at its lowest level.

DIRECTIONS: (continued)

Grease Traps: United 987 COLD-BAC BLOCK should be suspended in the trap so the block is just under the grease cap. Apply one block for every 350 gallons capacity. If capacity is over 500 gallons, spread the blocks out in different sections of the trap.

FIRST AID MEASURES:

IF IN EYES: Rinse thoroughly with water. Flush eyes for several minutes, lifting up eyelids. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing separately and clean shoes before reuse. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Appropriate protective gear should be worn. Remove to fresh air. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
